This document contains information and procedures for installing Compaq SANworks™ Command Scriptor version 1.0A on Microsoft Windows operating systems (Windows 2000 and Windows NT). The information in this document is current as of the release date and is subject to change.

Section I: Command Scriptor 1.0A Installation Instructions

This section describes requirements and procedures for installing Command Scriptor 1.0A on a host system running Microsoft Windows 2000 or Windows NT.

A. System Requirements

- To install Command Scriptor 1.0A on Microsoft Windows, you will need an account with administrator privileges.
- Command Scriptor 1.0A is installed from CmdScripter1.0aWinUpgradeOnly.exe. Identify the location from which to run the executable file if other than the system default location.
- Before installing SANworks Command Scriptor 1.0A, ensure Command Scriptor 1.0 has been installed on the system. Command Scriptor 1.0A will not install independently of Command Scriptor 1.0.

B. Command Scriptor 1.0A Installation

1. From the CmdScripter1.0aWinUpgradeOnly.zip destination folder or location, open the CmdScripter1.0aWinUpgradeOnly.exe file.

For example, if you unzipped the CmdScripter1.0aWinUpgradeOnly.zip to the Windows desktop, double-click the CmdScripter1.0aWinUpgradeOnly.exe icon.

The **InstallShield Wizard** displays.

2. Select the **Upgrade Command Scriptor** option (radio) button.
3. Click the **Next** button.
4. Click the **Finish** button. Command Scriptor 1.0A installs.



Section II: Instructions for Uninstalling Command Scriptor 1.0A

To uninstall Command Scriptor 1.0A from a host system running Windows 2000:

1. From the Windows desktop, select **Start**.
2. Select **Settings**.
3. Select **Control Panel**.
4. Select **Add/Remove Programs**.
5. Double-click **SANworks Command Scriptor**.
6. Click the **Change/Remove** button. The **InstallShield Wizard** displays.
7. Click the **Next** button. The **Question** screen displays.
8. Click **Yes** to remove all files in the directory, including customer scripts.
Click **No** to cancel the uninstall.
9. Click the **Finish** button.

Command Scriptor 1.0A uninstalls.

To uninstall Command Scriptor 1.0A from a host system running Windows NT:

1. From the Windows desktop, select **Start**.
2. Select **Settings**.
3. Select **Control Panel**.
4. Select **Add/Remove Programs**. The **Add/Remove Programs Properties** screen displays.
5. Select **SANworks Command Scriptor**.
6. Click the **Add/Remove** button. The **InstallShield Wizard** displays.
7. Select the **Uninstall Command Scriptor** option (radio) button.
10. Click the **Next** button. The **Question** screen displays.
11. Click **Yes** to remove all files in the directory, including customer scripts.
Click **No** to cancel the uninstall.
12. Click the **Finish** button.

Command Scriptor 1.0A uninstalls.
